### **What we do?**

Since 1998, our members and volunteers have worked to:

- Stop public land closures and restrictions in Douglas, Washoe, Lyon, Mineral and Mono Counties.
- Create awareness of potential policy changes that would restrict multi-use policies already in place.
- Promote safe and responsible use of public lands.
- Remove and properly dispose of more than 22 cars from public lands.
- Remove and properly dispose of over 2080 cubic yards of trash from public land.
- Develop, in conjunction with the BLM, several OHV trail heads in the Pine Nut Mountains, installing kiosks to communicate awareness of proper public use.
- Develop an OHV Volunteer Program to create awareness and promote responsible use of public lands.
- Raise money to fund our many projects and support our efforts to keep our public lands open for public use.

### **How can I get involved?**
